National Attendance Data:

The data shows that the attendance rate across the **academic year to date** was 92.5%. The absence rate was, therefore, 7.5% across all schools.

GSFED – better attendance than national data for all schools

By school type, the absence rates across the year to date were:

6.0% in state-funded primary schools (4.3% authorised and 1.6% unauthorised) – 94% attendance nationally in Primary Schools.
