

Also, congratulations to Cherry Blossom – they achieved 97.7%! A whole school effort and improved attendance this week.






On Monday, we enjoyed Maths Day! The children explored the book How Many Jelly Beans? A Giant Book of Giant Numbers.

They did so much learning! Shape, Fractions, Decimals, multiples and so much more!







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




World book day

On Tuesday 12th March we are going to Ashville College to perform at the Dance Festival in front of many other schools.


Our class will be performing the song / routine:
