## Working Together for Excellent Attendance.

#### Money owed

# There is a considerable amount of money owed for wraparound care, swimming transport, visits etc. Please check on ParentPay and settle outstanding amounts to bring accounts up to date.

Trips and visits cannot continue to go ahead unless the voluntary amount is received and this may result in them being cancelled.

Please note that if debts for wraparound care are not cleared, we will have to stop attendance.

We are very supportive of families and allow flexibility that other schools do not – most schools ask for payment in advance to confirm the place and expect a term paid in advance too.

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#### School Meal ordering on ParentPay

Thank you for your patience whilst we set up the new ordering system. The system went live during the Easter holiday and many parents ordered meals for their children.

Consolidating meal ordering into ParentPay means fewer apps/websites for you to navigate, as ordering and payment is done in one place. (Children eligible for free school meals do not pay, but you must order meals for your child).

Please check that you have ordered meals for your child for next week and beyond.

#### **Reminders:**

<u>Den building on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> April:</u> The children can **come to school** in their 'Outdoor Learning' clothes on the day of the workshop – no denim please. They will need lots of layers. The best clothing is jogging bottoms and a long-sleeved top. They will need a waterproof jacket. They could bring waterproof overtrousers too if they have some. Wellies or walking boots are preferred but if this is not possible, old trainers will do. Even if sunny the children will need to wear layers in light material, e.g. a long-sleeved top, sunscreen (check labels for nut oils/ allergies), and a hat but also be prepared for rain!

The children should bring their school uniform and shoes in their bag as they will all need a 'change of clothes' in case of inclement weather - they will potentially be wet and muddy following the workshop! If they are not too muddy they will stay in their outdoor kit all day.

Please also send a carrier bag in with your child to put wet / muddy clothes and shoes into.
