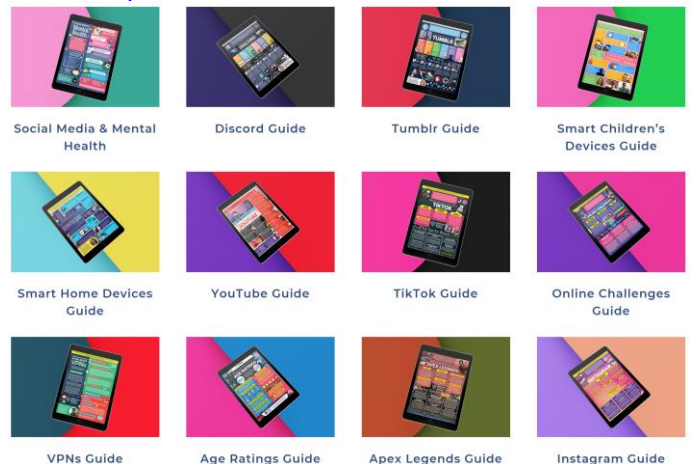


Use of Social Media and Online Games for 11s and under

Parents/carers may have seen the recent BBC Victoria Derbyshire documentary which raised concerns over the online game 'Roblox' and the suitability of the content within the game accessed by children as young as eight. Roblox, like many other online platforms popular with children of primary age, have parental controls and restrictions that can be activated but the risk to pupils accessing these games without the correct restrictions put in place for them remains clear. The list of games available to children grows daily and it is often difficult to keep up with the latest game that children are talking about with their friends. There are resources available that provide parents/carers with advice on how to keep their children safe when playing or interacting online.

A particularly good set of resources have been created by the National Online Safety Group- their series of guides for parents/carers set out what to look out for in popular online platforms such as Roblox, YouTube and Fortnite. The guides can be downloaded for free at this address:
